PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER, HIGHWAYS ACT 1980:

THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 12 (PART) – PARISH OF HOPTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2024

This Order is made by the Derbyshire County Council ("the Authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Longcliffe Quarries Limited of Longcliffe, Brassington have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Derbyshire Dales District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at New Harboro' Farm in Hopton Parish and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order or on such date as the Authority certifies that the work required to be done to bring the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public has been carried out (whichever is the later).
- 2. There shall, on such date as the Authority certifies that the work required to be done to bring the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public, be a public footpath over the land situate at New Harboro' Farm in Hopton Parish described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order.
- 3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Section as indicated on map **A-B**

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

The whole width of that part of Hopton Public Footpath No. 12 commencing at Point A (Ordnance Survey Grid Reference ("GR") SK 2459 5545 and proceeding in a generally east southeasterly, turning to a generally north easterly direction, then in a generally north north easterly direction to Point B (GR SK 2469 5550) a distance of 137 metres or thereabouts.

PART 2

Section as indicated on map

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A-C-D-E-B

A 2 metre wide grass surfaced footpath at New Harboro' Farm in the Parish of Hopton, with a concrete surface between Point C (GR SK 2460 5545) and Point D (GR SK 2460 5545), commencing from the aforementioned Point A (GR SK 2459 5545) and proceeding in a generally north easterly direction then turning to a southeasterly direction to point B (GR SK 2469 5550 a distance of 120 metres or thereabouts.


